

Even if a student isn't from this area, they can still take our CDL Theon, training. Our curriculum is fully compliant with the current FMCS ELDT Training standards and we are a member in good standing of the Training Provider Registry as a Theory provider.

Once a student has completed our ELDT Theory they will need to get Behind-the-Wheel training before they can take the third party test to get their CDL.

The problem with Theory only programs is that students can't get their CDL if they only complete Theory! How will they get connected with a local company and get the training they need to get on the road?

That is our niche! We want our students to find their dream job right here in South Dakota, so we have created a directory for SDTA member businesses that are willing to take on individuals with a CLF and help them get Behind-the-Wheel training or be referred to a Behind-the-Wheel trainer to get their full CDL.

How It Works



Theory Training

This portion is completed fully online. A student can do it in the comfort of their own home. This program meets and exceeds the federal minimum standard for Theory, training. The training should take approximately 13 hours to complete.

Behind-the-Wheel Training

This portion of the training happens in a truck with a trainer who is an experienced CDL holder. A student can do our Theory training and find their own Range and Roac Training, or they can go with one of our recommended companies and get both training and possibly a job!



Hazmat Endorsement Training

This online training course meets and exceeds the federal minimum standards for Hazardous Materials Theory training. The course covers the 13 required Hazardous Materials topics. The training should take a student or driver approximately 2 hours to complete.

CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE



I am writing this after returning from the East River Legislative Reception in Sioux Falls. The event was held at Minera's. We had a very good attendance of both legislators and SDTA members. These events are so important as they allow SDTA members to be in front of a large number of legislators at one time. Take time to look at the pic-

tures of both the West and East River Legislative Socials on page 29 of this publication.

Tesla has completed a test of a truck weighing 81,000 pounds. It traveled 500 miles on a single charge. I don't know where they ran the test, but I am sure it was done under ideal conditions - not in the mountains or in cold weather. I don't know where they plan to get the power to supply converting to zero emissions. The power grid will not supply existing electric vehicles. Weight is another factor! With the battery weight of 11,000 pounds, this will take away from the carrying capacity, thus increasing the number of trucks on the road to move the same tonnage. I know this does not affect most carriers, but for the ag sector this is a big deal! The FMCSA has denied the petition for an exemption on the hours-ofservice. Nothing is going to change how the load of cattle or other live loads will still be moved. There is no other way of doing it.

With the holidays upon us, please have a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!

Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year to you and your families! While the holidays and year-end are a crazy busy time of year for businesses, it's important to pause and reflect on 2022. My hope and prayer for you is that you get some time with friends and family. I'm excited to spend the last week of December with my 3 boys. No major plans just to be with them as they continue to grow up and are getting to be a little too cool for their mom.

Early in December, the rail strike was put to an end after Congress intervened and forced the contract to move forward. There were only 4 unions that weren't in agreement with the contract. The strike could have been damning to our economy, with an estimated \$2 BILLION in losses per day. Both parties put their differences aside and moved forward, putting the rail strike to rest for now. A diverse transportation system is critical for keeping goods moving across our nation.

Recently, we participated in a webinar that highlighted all the major lawsuits surrounding the trucking industry that ATA has been leading the charge on. While it was a little depressing, there have been some big wins across the nation standing up for the trucking industry. Winning the Rhode Island toll case was really big, but we don't anticipate that it's not over or that other states won't try to do something similar. They were simply trying to discriminate against truck drivers by charging more to pass through tolls. We still continue to see a large increase in lawsuits targeting trucking companies and drivers. ATA is assisting several states in bringing legislation to protect against these huge settlements, which can often put a company out of business. SDTA has had discussions about this, but no legislation has been drafted as of today.

Lastly, it's with a little bit of a selfish heart that I let you all know that Rick Hoogendoorn has retired after 38 years at Yellow. As you know, Rick has served as the ATA Chair for SDTA as well as on the Executive Committee and last year's hiring committee. We certainly wish Rick the best, but we also recognize these are some big shoes to fill.

RULES:

Driver may be nominated for Driver of the Month for any outstanding act of heroism, a contribution to highway safety, an extraordinary act of courtesy, an exceptional deed or act of service to mankind within the community reflecting positively on the motor carrier industry, or for a long period of safe and courteous driving. An outstanding act shall be deemed to mean unusual or other than the normal every day courtesies afforded by truck drivers.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. The nominated driver must be an employee of a member in good standing of the South Dakota Trucking Association.
- 2. The nominated driver must have been an employee by the present employer for at least two years and have a minimum of five years overall experience.
- 3. South Dakota domiciled* drivers are eligible for nomination for an outstanding act performed in any state. * The intent of the word "domiciled" shall be interpreted to mean: Any driver reporting to or regularly dispatched from a terminal within the state of SD (in keeping with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations definition of his/her home terminal) regardless of where the driver may dwell.
- 4. A driver may receive the Driver of the Month award only one time in any contest year. He/she may be renominated in any subsequent year.
- 5. Nominations for outstanding acts on the highway shall be accompanied by supporting evidence (letters, statements, news clippings, etc.). A clear, factual account is absolutely necessary. Vague generalizations will not be accepted.
- 6. A copy of recent driver motor vehicle record check must accompany the nomination.
- 7. Drivers nominated and not selected as Driver of the Month will be held over and used in the following month's selection.
- 8. Entries must be in the SDTA office no later than the 10th of each month for that current month's contest.
- 9. Nominations may be made by any party, but must be approved by the employer or a representative of the employer.
- 10. The annual contest will run from September of the previous year through August of the current year.
- 11. Company agrees to submit a professional head and shoulders photo of the winning driver.

Gov. Noem and Gov. Gordon Tell Forest Service to Revise Assessments for Black Hills National Forest



PIERRE, S.D. — This week, Governor Kristi Noem and Wyoming Governor Mark Gordon urged the Supervisor of the Black Hills National Forest to produce another set of draft assessments for the Forest's Plan Revision process. "We request that the Forest Service produce another set of draft assessments with a public comment period, that those assessments include citations for factual statements, and that they contain discussion of why one authority was relied upon over another," wrote Governor Noem. "We look


forward to meaningful participation in the Black Hills National Forest's Forest Plan Revision process."


In recent years, timber mills in the Black Hills have struggled to keep the doors of their business. Under logging constraints, one mill has already closed in South Dakota.

"We are concerned about the apparent desire of the Forest Service to drastically reduce the timber program in the Black Hills National Forest," continued Governors Noem.

The Governors pointed to flawed statements "not backed by scientific material" in the Black Hills National Forest Plan revision assessments. These flaws included errors in both the data analysis and assumptions in the Black Hills Timber Sustainability General Technical Report.

"If the inaccuracies are not addressed, it will be difficult for our states to have confidence in the outcome of the Forest Plan Revision," wrote the Governors.


